Guidelines for online class at CZU FEM with the help of Google Hangouts Meet (G Suite for education)

Requirements for using the Hangouts Meet service

To use the Google Hangouts Meet service you need a supported web browser, or the mobile phone application Meet.

- You must be logged in to your G Suite account (@ pef.czu.cz, @ g.pef.czu.cz) to create a Meet video call.
- You don't need a G Suite account to join Meet video calls, you can use a different Google Account (such as @ gmail.com), or you can connect anonymously.

Anybody can join by using a link or by entering the meeting ID. Uninvited - anonymous Meet guest (such as a student) must be approved by the video call founder after the meeting starts.

Operating system and browser requirements

Before you start using Hangouts, make sure your computer meets the following requirements:

Operating systems where Hangouts Meet works

Hangouts Meet works in the current version and the two previous major versions of these operating systems:

- Microsoft Windows
- Apple Mac OS
- Chrome OS
- Ubuntu and more distributions from Linux/Debian.

Web browsers where Hangouts Meet works

Hangouts Meet works with the latest versions of these browsers:

- Google Chrome
- Mozilla Firefox
- Microsoft Edge
- Apple Safari

Allow access to the camera and microphone

If you are launching Hangouts Meet from your computer or mobile device, then make sure to allow the application to use your microphone and camera. Make sure to check the Hangouts system requirements before starting your first video call. If you are not asked to allow access, or you have previously blocked access, you can change your settings at meet.google.com.
